



The October Mission of the Month will be supporting Care Partners of Cook County. This nonprofit uses mostly trained volunteers to provide many services for elderly or disabled people in our county. Some of the many services include senior rides, household chores and delivery, caregiver support, end of life planning and care, companionship, grief support groups and training for volunteers. Clients do pay for many services on a sliding scale based on income, but payments do not cover the cost of services.

We want to give monetary support to keep these vital services going. We also want to participate with hands on labor during the "fall chore days" event happening on October 24th and 25th. Clients will make requests to Care Partners for help with chores such as raking, garden clean up, moving outdoor furniture to storage, & garage cleaning. Volunteers will be matched up with tasks. Most tasks will take two hours or less, depending on number of volunteers.

This will be a great opportunity for families and all generations to participate together. There will be sign-up sheets in the narthex for interested volunteers, or call the church office. There will be Friday afternoon, Saturday morning, and Saturday afternoon times available. Care Partners will have specific task requests by the middle of October, so we will be able to give our volunteers their assignments.

We hope that people who are unable to support their work with hands-on labor doing fall chores will want to support their work with a monetary gift. Volunteers don't need to provide their own materials for carpentry, cleaning, cooking, or gas for driving people to appointments.

Monetary donations to Bethlehem for this Mission of the Month should be marked for "Care Partners." For your convenience, we have 'Mission of the Month' envelopes in the Narthex.

The Best Gift for Your Pastor
